

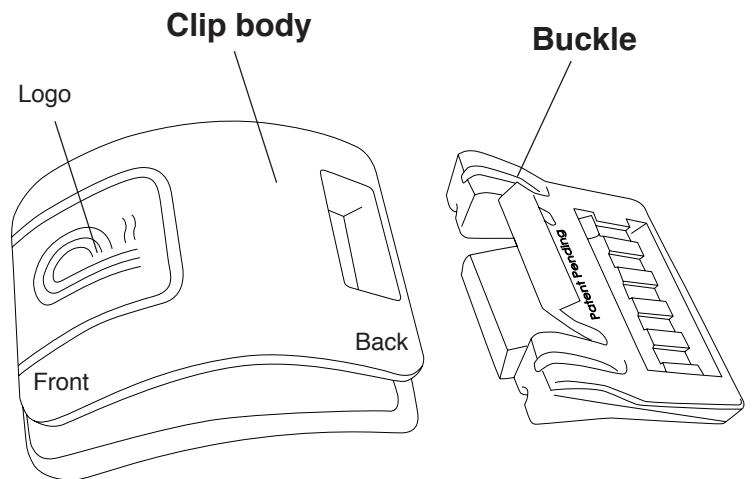


## PIRANHA CLIP INSTRUCTIONS

The Piranha Clip comprises of two parts, the clip body which is clipped onto the edge of the pool cover with the logo uppermost. The buckle part is attached to the reel strap and slides into the clip body locking it in place.

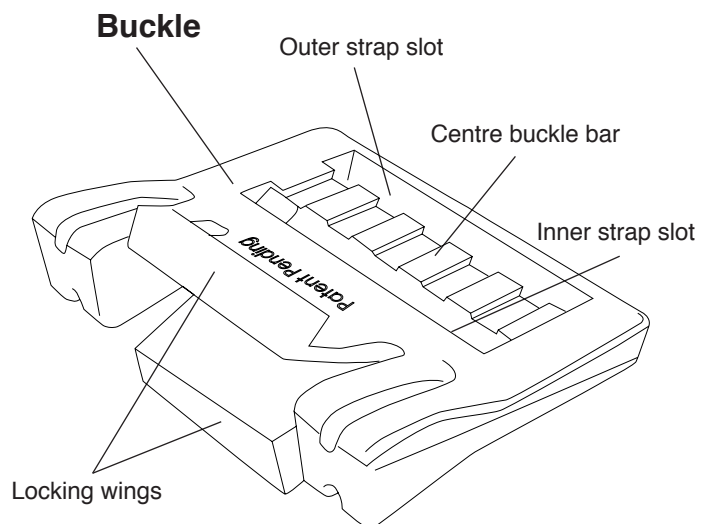
### STEP 1

Grip the clip body at the back edge and pinch to open the jaws while positioning on the cover edge. The cover should go in up to the central vertical bar inside the clip. The position of all the clips can be fitted and adjusted before moving on to STEP 2.



### STEP 2

Hold the buckle with the flat side of the centre buckle bar facing up. Thread the end of the strap up through the inner strap slot and then back down through the outer strap slot.





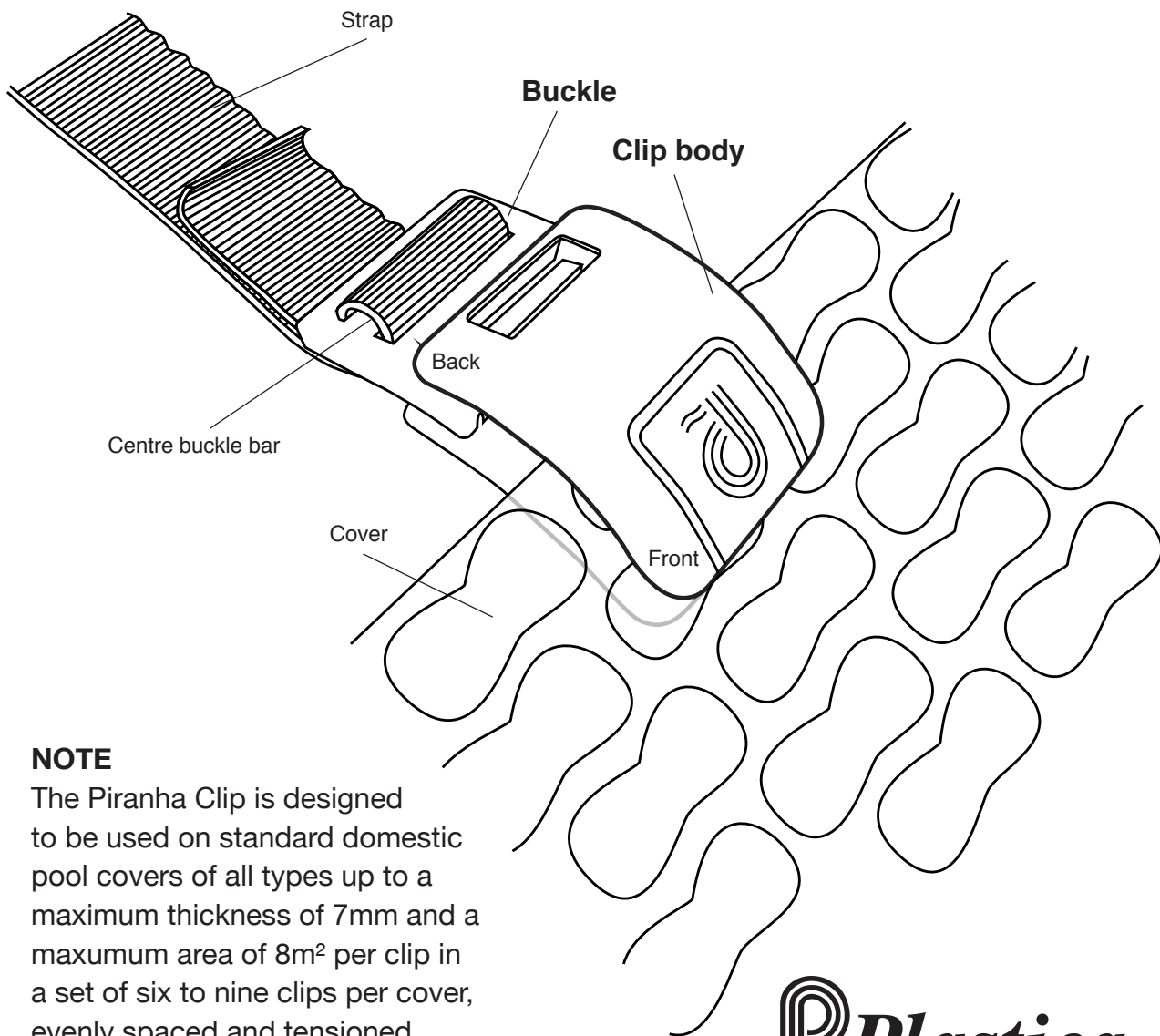
## PIRANHA CLIP INSTRUCTIONS

### STEP 3

Slide the strapped buckle into the side of the clip body by pinching the locking wings flat. Ensure the buckle is exactly central.

### STEP 4

Holding the clip body firmly onto the cover by the front edge pull on both sections of the reel strap to slide the buckle backwards. The locking wings will click into place securing the assembly.



### NOTE

The Piranha Clip is designed to be used on standard domestic pool covers of all types up to a maximum thickness of 7mm and a maximum area of 8m<sup>2</sup> per clip in a set of six to nine clips per cover, evenly spaced and tensioned.
