- 1) The reasons we purchased Heatsavr was due to the design of our main pool, because it has a fixed boom separating it when one part of the pool is in use but not the other we are unable to cover it and thus was losing a lot of heat and water evaporation. Plus our old convention main pool cover and teaching pool cover was in need of replacement at a staggering cost, and also the manual handling of putting on and removing the old pool covers by the staff.

- 2) The quality of the air in the pool hall has improved dramatically since Heatsavr was installed; we are now able to have covers over the pools that are not in use even when people are using the other pool. We have also seen a slight reduction in the chemical usage of our pools as well since it was installed due to the reduction of evaporation from the pools.

- 3) I would recommend Heatsavr to someone who is unsure about having it on their pool system without hesitation, I have found it to be a true 'Fit and Forget' product with easy installation and maintenance free usage, apart from re ordering chemical yearly and topping up the day tank every month.

- 4) It is difficult for us to quantify actual savings in energy terms due to our building management system and the mild winter we have just had, but in real world terms we have seen our pool air humidity drop from 60-70% down to 30-40%. I have been able to reduce our ventilation fan speeds down 50% during opening hours and 70% over night. Condensation has dropped to virtually nothing even when our ventilation system was off for a period of time due to repairs. I have also been able to reduce the amount of heat that's is being supplied to the pool water over night and also the lifeguards report it's a lot nicer climate for them to work in and for customers to swim in as well.
